

## Centella Asiatica Extract – Technical Data Sheet (1% Asiaticoside)

<b>Botanical Source</b>	Centella asiatica (L.) – Leaf and Stem
Specification	1% Asiaticoside (HPLC)
Physical Form	Fine green to brown powder
Smell	Mild herbal, characteristic
Solubility in Water	~10-15 g/L at 45-60 °C with stirring
Solubility in Oil	Practically insoluble
Recommended Solubilization Method	<ul> <li>Disperse in warm water (~50–60 °C)</li> <li>Stir thoroughly for 5–10 minutes</li> <li>Filter to remove insolubles if needed</li> </ul>
Cosmetic Functions	Skin conditioning, antioxidant, soothing
Recommended Use Level	0.5–2% (in water phase)
Preservation/Handling	Store in a tightly sealed container in a cool, dry, dark place
Shelf Life	24 months in unopened original packaging under proper storage
Toxicity Criteria	
NOAEL	1000 mg/kg bw/day (oral, 90-day rat study)
LD50	>2000 mg/kg bw (oral, rat)
Genotoxicity	Negative in vitro and in vivo studies
